Presented across three nights, The Book of Daughters was a large-scale sonic media performance cycle comprising nine 20-40 min shows created by multiple maverick sound artists and musicians in various creative combinations. Featuring leading sound makers such as Yoshimio (Boredoms and OOIOO) and Australia's own Carolyn Connors (acclaimed vocalist), The Book of Daughters was a suite of sonic explorations by JOLT's community of artists. The project features in-house JOLT ensembles presenting new works alongside internationally celebrated sound artists.

Years ago, when I first saw Jolt Arts at Federation Square conducting the Amplified Elephants, it was clear to me that I had witnessed one of the most profound sonic performances I'd experienced to date.

We will bell to let you know when and sit.

During performances, the bar will be closed, but you are most welcome to take drinks to your seats, and of course, please turn off your mobile phones for a very special reason in that the ABC are recording this show tonight so, if you haven't - it now.
